

Bremer Sanctuary Summer Bird Hike

Saturday, June 4th, 7:00am

Our Summer Hike will focus on the migrating species: warblers, vireos, tanagers, sparrows along with all the resident birds. Good chances for viewing of Indigo Bunting, Eastern Towhee, Summer Tanager and Common Yellowthroat are possible.



Resident species such as Red-headed Woodpeckers, Blue Jays, Tufted Titmouse, Northern Cardinals and Eastern Bluebirds will be present. Nest box checks will be explained and demonstrated.



Guided easy level hiking for 90 minutes leaves promptly at 7:00am. Dress for the weather...Wear sturdy shoes or boots, hat and apply bug repellent. Bring binoculars and a bottle of water. Light breakfast items available after the hike. Open to the public.
